Last week the company celebrated International Disability Day in the copper belt as well and distributed 500 masks to the specially abled, as the Covid scare has resurfaced with the new variant Omicron. 20, 000 masks are being distributed in communities in and around the communities in proximity of KCM. Recently Vedanta handed over sanitary napkins to the district authorities for the girlchild in schools in Chingola and Chilebomwe to help reduce dropouts. As well distributing sanitisers and masks.

The Vedanta team is currently on ground in the copper belt and are grateful to the community for their support on the CSR activities undertaken by Vedanta. It has resumed the anti-malaria awareness campaign and will undertake the responsibility to spray 3400 households before the onset of monsoons with the help of 50 local youths who will undertake the spraying. Other measures are being discussed with local authorities and the communities.

Vedanta Resources has spent in the past around US\$200 million on community programmes focusing on safety, environment and socio-economic development at KCM. One of the objectives is to revive the significant CSR programs which were expansive and collaborate with the local authorities & Zambian communities. These CSR initiatives which included; two hospitals and 14 satellite clinics, a 90% reduction in malaria incidents, starting and funding three football clubs, the introduction of an adult literacy programme, and providing safe drinking water to over 8,000 people through solar powered boreholes.
